mLINQS Earns FedRAMP Authorization

FAIRFAX, VA – (September 14, 2017) – mLINQS, LLC today announced that the company’s hosting service has received an Authority to Operate (ATO) from the Federal Risk and Authorization Management Program (FedRAMP). The FedRAMP Authorization will greatly streamline the process for customers to adopt and use mLINQS’ cloud hosted relocation system.

“mLINQS is the only relocation system provider to earn FedRAMP Authorization and, broadly speaking, mLINQS is one of just a few Software as a Service (SaaS) companies to earn the FedRAMP designation,” said Greg McIntyre, President, mLINQS. “This FedRAMP Authorization is the culmination of many months of work by our staff and is a major milestone for our company. FedRAMP is a large undertaking but achievable by vendors willing to apply themselves and invest in the process. The bottom line is this will greatly reduce the cost for our federal customers and significantly enhance the value of our offering.”

The government estimates that FedRAMP Authorization reduces the costs of cloud migration by 30 to 40 percent. The Authorization will also assist mLINQS customers to comply with the “Presidential Executive Order on Strengthening the Cybersecurity of Federal Networks and Critical Infrastructure” signed on May 11, 2017. That order noted, in part, federal agencies need to be using secure cloud-based services to improve efficiency and lower overall IT costs.

mLINQS’ relocation system (moveLINQ) is the only fully compliant, Web-based government employee relocation expense management system. Developed by mLINQS staff in 2004, moveLINQ is used to support relocation for the employees of over 35 federal agencies, including 11 of the 15 federal executive departments.
