mLINQS Announces Newest Version of Government Relocation Expense Management System

FAIRFAX, VA – (October 27, 2008) – mLINQS, LLC today announced the company's imminent release of moveLINQ[®] v5.0, a highly advanced version of the first and only fully functional relocation expense management system developed exclusively for use by federal agencies. The nine new major upgrades to the system's functionality were designed based upon customer feedback mLINQS received during its inaugural User Group Meeting held last June in Atlanta.

The enhancements can keep users ahead of federal mandates for greater accountability of their relocation costs, while further streamlining their expense management processes. Rated most important by existing customers is the new functionality for Routing and Workflow, and Document Tracking Stamps.

Routing and Workflow provides users with the ability to better facilitate, manage and track business processes surrounding expense management operations within a federal agency. Key features include automated e-mail notifications and document routing.

The Document Tracking Stamps functionality will enable agencies to track the current status and history of a relocation document. Agency configurable stamps provide users with more robust and flexible expense processing capabilities when managing the expenses of government transferees. Other enhancements in moveLINQ v5.0 include:

- Receipt and Electronic Document Management (EDM)
- Increased Budgetary and Funds De-Obligation controls
- New Relocation Summary tab
- Additional Accounting Code Allocation options
- Streamlined Household Goods and Real Estate screens
- Platform upgrade for underlying Microsoft .NET Framework and SQL Server database.

EDM capability for information management systems in many diverse applications is recognized as critical for migrating to and maintaining a paperless environment. moveLINQ's new Receipt and Electronic Document Management functionality ensures federal agencies can upload and store supporting electronic files and receipts to transferees' relocation orders and vouchers within the system.
