mLINQS Releases Enhanced Government Relocation Expense Management System

- RITA (Relocation Income Tax Allowance) voucher processing.
- TQ (Temporary Quarters) calculations.
- Real estate allowance controls to enforce agency policy for all domestic and international moves.

moveLINQ is designed around end-to-end expense management scenarios that deliver a user-friendly, total expense management solution right out of the box. The system adheres to all civilian and Defense Department regulations ensuring full compliance in a secure, fully scalable environment.
