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### **mLINQS Responds to GSA Relocation Reporting Requirement With New Federal Expense Management System Enhancement**

**FAIRFAX, VA – (June 17, 2015)** – mLINQS, LLC today announced the company has completed an enhancement to its moveLINQ relocation expense management system in response to the General Services Administration (GSA) Federal Travel Regulation Bulletin, FTR 15-04. This GSA Bulletin serves to notify federal agencies of the requirement to report relocation costs each fiscal year.

The mLINQS software enhancement is immediately available to existing federal agency customers. It will enable them to quickly and easily comply with the GSA requirement.

“moveLINQ users will be able to provide all the relocation expense information GSA has requested with just a few clicks by accessing a new report utility in our system,” said Greg McIntyre, president, mLINQS. “We built the report after a comprehensive review of the GSA requirements, which included requesting clarification from GSA where the requirements appeared vague. All the while, we coordinated the information and our approach with our diverse and large customer base in the federal government. Despite the many stakeholders that we involved, our developers were able to complete the enhancement in less than a month, which gives customers about 45 days to meet the GSA deadline for filing their reports.”

In the Bulletin, GSA directed all agencies to provide relocation cost data for fiscal years 2012, 2013, and 2014, using an Excel format that contains 11 separate categories of payments in each year. All of this data is stored electronically by their moveLINQ systems, and can be accessed through the software’s standard menu. The information will then be used by GSA to help with future decisions concerning relocation policy, and in a report it will provide to the Office of Management and Budget.

moveLINQ is the only fully compliant, Web-based government employee relocation expense management system. Originally developed in-house by mLINQS staff in 2004, it is used to support relocation for the employees of over 35 federal agencies, including 11 of the 15 federal executive departments. mLINQS managed hosting service customers have access to the system 24X7 in a federally-compliant IT infrastructure designed and maintained to achieve Authority to Operate (ATO) in accordance with Assessment & Authorization (A&A) standards with federal agency requirements.
