The first version of moveLINQ was released in March 2004. mLINQS developed the system in response to input from relocation managers in multiple federal agencies. mLINQS and these federal agencies recognized the need for a comprehensive Web-based system to better manage the costs associated with relocating employees, enable full regulatory compliance, and help to reduce the stress federal employees experience when moving to a new location. The solution was moveLINQ.

At the time, moveLINQ was the first system of its kind designed solely for use by federal agencies. It remains unique in the government marketplace, and today this award winning system has been deployed to support relocation for the employees of more than 30 federal agencies.
